If you haven't already, now is the time to register for the 23rd Annual Puget Sound Buddy Walk to be held at Woodland Park Zoo on Sunday, October 6th. The Zoo has generously waived admission for that day to all pre-registered attendees of the Puget Sound Buddy Walk! Feel free to arrive early and enjoy the Zoo prior to the Walk beginning (Zoo hours that day are 9:30 AM to 4:00 PM). Then join over 1,200 friends and supporters for an afternoon of fun including activities for the family, resource booths, artists with Down syndrome, food trucks, team photos, and of course, a walk around Woodland Park Zoo. After the Walk ends, join us for a silent disco!



Important items to know for this year's registration:

- Everyone MUST pre-register for the Walk to receive free admission to the Zoo that day. There will be no exceptions. Anyone coming the day of for the Walk who has not pre-registered will have to pay to enter the Zoo. Online registration will close at noon the day prior to the Walk (10/5);
- Register early! Registration is free, t-shirts are \$12 each and free for those with Down syndrome. Purchase t-shirts by this Friday, September 13, to guarantee size. We will have limited sizes and quantities available for purchase at the Walk for \$15.
